#### Introduction

In Chapter 6 of *The Maitreya Discourses*, we read another important dictation for the sincere student on the path. In this dictation, the ascended master Kuthumi builds on the instruction of Lord Maitreya in Chapter 5. Kuthumi offers clear explanations of how the dweller-on-the-threshold operates. Because of the length of this dictation and the important concepts it contains, we have once again created a study guide of questions that will help you go more deeply into the key concepts in the chapter. We recommend completing this Part 1: Study Guide individually or in a group before continuing to the group discussion and personal reflection questions in Part 2. The section headings and page numbers will help you reference specific passages in the chapter.

## **Dictation Summary**

In this dictation, Kuthumi comes to us as both a student of Lord Maitreya and a teacher on his behalf. He offers additional instruction on Lord Maitreya's teachings on the principle of accommodation and announces a precious dispensation from Lord Maitreya that any sincere student on the path will want to use.

# **Core Concept**

Kuthumi teaches in great detail on the differences between accommodating the dweller and slaying the dweller, including how we can be fooled into thinking we have presented the acceptable offering to God when we have not yet done so. He explains that the only acceptable offering is the ascension.

For you are so sincere, and the sweetness of thy hearts is touching to the soul in a world hardened by war and abortion.
